This award was created to honor individuals who represent the very best of Hartford Hospital and who have inspired their colleagues with outstanding career-long achievements and years of dedicated service to our hospital, patients, and community.

Dr. Jacobs—the second recipient of the Hartford Hospital Lifetime Achievement Award—has been an influential and beloved leader at Hartford Hospital since he arrived in 1983 to serve as Director of Trauma and Emergency Medicine. He was instrumental in establishing the LIFE STAR program and helping Hartford Hospital to become the region's first Level 1 Trauma Center.

Dr. Jacobs' impact has been felt worldwide, as he has been credited with training trauma surgeons across the globe through the Advanced Trauma Operation Management (ATOM) course he developed. He led the creation of the American College of Surgeons' "Stop the Bleed" campaign and is considered a great advocate for the poor and vulnerable—with a strong commitment to equity in healthcare. In 2022, the Lenworth M. Jacobs Trauma Lecture was named in his honor.

Dr. Jacobs has saved countless lives with his surgical skills, the programs he initiated, and the knowledge he has passed down. He has been described as a pioneer in trauma, a visionary in healthcare equity, and one of the true icons of Hartford Hospital. Tonight, we thank and congratulate Dr. Jacobs for embodying our values and the significant contributions he has made to our hospital and the communities we serve.

Hartford Hospital and its philanthropic supporters are celebrating Hartford Hospital's Emergency Department (ED) as the beneficiary of this year's Black & Red.

Hartford Hospital, as a leading tertiary medical center of Hartford HealthCare, serves as a major gateway to our region's most advanced care and the medical home to world-class physicians, nurses, and healthcare professionals highly trained and experienced in their specialties—the Emergency Department attends to patients and families from our region and beyond who require immediate medical attention. The ED treats over 100,000 adult patients each year—with conditions ranging from major trauma and heart attacks to strokes and childbirth, as well as many other highly acute and minor illnesses and injuries—who arrive via walk-in, automobile, ambulance, and LIFE STAR helicopter.

Over 20,000 patients are admitted to the hospital each year through our Emergency Department, where they first encounter the speed, skill, and professionalism that has earned the ED its accreditation as a Level I Trauma Center, Stroke Center, and Chest Pain Center.

Net proceeds from the 2024 Black & Red will directly support Emergency Department infrastructure, staffing, and the department's continuous pursuit of providing accessible, equitable, and high-quality healthcare to whoever comes through its doors.

Jennifer Hudson

A two-time GRAMMY® Award-winning recording artist, Academy Award-winning actress, and Tony and Emmy Award-winning producer, **Jennifer Hudson** is the youngest female EGOT winner in history. From humble beginnings, Hudson began singing in a small Chicago church where, week after week, she brought the congregation to its feet.

From there, she's gone on to worldwide acclaim. Hudson is currently starring in her nationally syndicated talk show, *The Jennifer Hudson Show*, which features her powerful voice in a new way—bringing fun, uplifting, and empowering conversations to the forefront.

In 2007, Hudson won an Academy Award for her role as Effie in the smash hit *Dreamgirls*. She later cemented her historic EGOT status by earning a Tony Award as co-producer on 2022's Best Musical, A *Strange Loop*. This followed her electrifying turn as Aretha Franklin in the critically acclaimed biopic, *Respect*, a role for which she was handpicked by Franklin and garnered her a Screen Actors Guild nomination. She was named "Entertainer of the Year" at the 2022 NAACP Image Awards and one of *Time* magazine's "Most Influential People in the World."

Hudson has starred in countless film and television projects, released chart-topping albums, made her Broadway debut in the Tony Award-winning production of *The Color Purple*, and has been a celebrated coach on both the US and UK versions of the Emmy Award winning juggernaut *The Voice*.
